2013 ACNP Joel Elkes Research Award

- 1. The American College of Neuropsychopharmacology (ACNP) presents the Joel Elkes Research Award to a young scientist in recognition of an outstanding clinical contribution to neuropsychopharmacology.
2. Any scientist, worldwide, may nominate an individual for this award by submitting to the Awards Committee:
a. The nominating letter (no more than three pages) should include a description of the contribution(s) of the candidate, and also the significance of his/her contribution(s);
b. The curriculum vitae of the candidate;
c. No more than three papers representing the contribution(s) (career contributions or specific works) upon which the Award would be based.
3. The recipient of the Elkes Research Award must be fifty (50) years of age or younger as of December 31, 2013. He/she does not need to be a member of the ACNP or a citizen of the United States.
