1. The Panel is not sufficiently cohesive.
2. The Panel is not sufficiently innovative.
3. The Panel does not include sufficient novel/new data.
4. The theme of the Panel is over-represented in current submissions for this year.
5. Similar Panels have been presented in recent ACNP meetings.
6. The abstract is not informative enough.
7. Speakers are not from diverse institutions.
8. For Posters: Insufficient data and/or statistical analyses.
